



Ana Delia Lopez

April 2, 1928 - September 17, 2022

Ana Delia Lopez, 94, of Peekskill, New York, passed peacefully in her home, on Saturday, September 17, 2022, after a fulfilling and impactful life.

Doña Ana as she was affectionally called, was born on April 2, 1928, to Pedro Antonio Torres and Ana Delia del Carmen Gonzalez, in the Dominican Republic.

Doña Ana and her husband, Jose Lopez, in a blended family raised a total of 13 children: Lucy (Maris), Doris, Teresa, Idalia, Rafael, Jose, Minerva, Luis Roberto, Nelson, Victor Jose, Julio, Marisa, and Griselda.

Her granddaughter, Cheryl Sonilal, reflected that: "Our grandmother was a woman with infinite wisdom, the web that kept the family intact. She held you accountable, mediated, rectified, and forgave. She was a woman of faith. In her eyes, no one was above God. She was vivacious -- always laughing, dancing, lively, happy. She lived a FULL life, a hard life, but a good life focused on the well-being of those around her. A legacy; transcendent."

Her grandson, Kevin Sonilal, reflected that: "...our Matriarch was a force to be reckoned with. She commanded respect. When she spoke, you listened and never challenged her wise authority. She always had your best interest at heart. She could throw down in the kitchen - OMG, her Sancocho!!! She was funny and witty, and threw the best parties "en El Hoyo." My grandmother could make something out of nothing, and was incredibly hard-working ... she was a Renaissance woman."

Doña Ana is predeceased by her sons Luis Roberto and Nelson, and her grandchildren Victor Manuel and Leslie Massiel. She leaves behind a legacy of 26 grandchildren, 26 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great grandchildren.

Memorial Services will be held in Tarrytown, New York on September 25 and 26th, 2022.

The remains of our beloved Ana Delia Lopez will be laid to rest in her native Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.
