



## Anne (Pedlow) Hodge

October 30, 1927 - August 5, 2015

Anne Hodge, longtime resident of Pocantico Hills, died at Cedar Manor Nursing Home, Ossining, New York on August 5, 2015 after a brief illness. The last of five siblings, she was born to Jane and Arthur Pedlow on October 30, 1927 in Crumlin, County Antrim, Northern Ireland. Orphaned at age 8, she was raised by her aunt in County Monaghan, Ireland. While working at Pattons she met her future husband the late James G. Hodge. She immigrated to the United States in 1950 and they were wed on January 20, 1951. They first settled in Norfolk, Virginia where her husband was stationed in the army for two years. He predeceased her on April 3, 1994. They returned to Pocantico in 1953 and settled there to raise their three children. She was a member of the Union Church of Pocantico Hills. She enjoyed painting and was an avid knitter and loved watching professional wrestling. Anne is survived by her children Greer P. of Pocantico Hills, Gary C. (Janet) of Plymouth Meeting, PA and Jane E. (George) of Greenvale, New York and five grandchildren, Jason (Kristen), Ryan, Evan, Trevor, and Phoebe.
