October 23, 1954 - October 8, 2019

We celebrate the life of Anne Carolyn Rybicki, 64, who passed away on October 8, 2019, in Westchester, NY. A native of Staten Island, Anne attended Notre Dame Academy and Rutgers University, after which she received a Ph.D. in biochemistry from Drexel University. Following post-doctoral fellowships at the University of Chicago and Children's Hospital Oakland Research Institute, Anne joined the faculty of Albert Einstein College of Medicine, Division of Hematology, where she conducted research on blood cell diseases, including sickle cell anemia. After retiring from Einstein, Anne went on to become an Adjunct Professor at Mercy College and Westchester Community College where she taught courses including biochemistry and anatomy and physiology. In addition to Anne's scientific and academic achievements she was also a loving wife to her husband Robert Schwartz, and a devoted mother to Laura Cody Schwartz, who will love her for the rest of their lives, and hold her close inside their hearts until the end of time. Anne also leaves behind three devoted brothers, Thomas, William and Stanley Rybicki, loving mother-in-law Tillie Schwartz and loving brother-in-law William Schwartz, and many loving nieces and nephews. Anne's life, which ended abruptly and tragically, was symbolic of her glass always full character, letting the light shine through her to the those she loved and who loved her. Never one for seeking attention, Anne instead was the person holding the camera, being the caregiver, providing comfort and support and filling the room with happiness. Despite being blessed with natural beauty, Anne was most

interested in sharing her internal beauty, spirituality and endless capacity to love. Anne had an unending curiosity, was an avid reader and never tired of learning. The world has lost an earthly angel. Those who were fortunate enough to have known and loved Anne wish her a speedy and safe passage to eternal joy.
