



## Bernard Schwartzberg

October 15, 1939 - February 27, 2025

Dr. Bernard Schwartzberg died on February 27, 2025 at the age of 85. The son of Morris and Tillie (Lackowitz) Schwartzberg, he was born and raised in Brooklyn, later moved to New York City and then to Westchester County, NY. He is mourned by his wife Katharine St. Vincent, his sons Robert and Steven and their wives, and four grandchildren. Dr. Schwartzberg was a man of many interests. He was an avid reader and loved music of all kinds. As a young adult, he reached the rank of Black Belt in Karate while teaching high school mathematics at a school in Harlem. After graduating from City College with a degree in Physics, he began to pursue a doctorate in mathematics at the Courant Institute of NYU but decided to change his focus to psychoanalysis. He earned a Doctorate in Psychology at Hofstra University and then a postdoctoral degree at the American Institute for Psychoanalysis. For more than half a century as a private therapist, he counseled patients to face and view life's challenges as opportunities for growth. Many

patients have reached out to the family to express their gratitude for the difference he made in their lives.

A dedicated husband and father, Bernie especially adored his grandchildren. He also had a

great interest in and respect for all the creatures of the animal kingdom. For those wishing
