Bruce Redmond Buckley was born December 19, 1935 in Queens, NY to Amelia (nee) Stanbridge and Harry Buckley.

Bruce attended Columbia University where he discovered a passion for journalism that would lead to his founding the Morningsider, a newspaper focusing on the upper west side of Manhattan. He married Joan Norkelun in 1960 .They shared a son, Tod, born in 1963.

Bruce went on to focus on pharmaceutical writing, serving as editor for several trade publications, including Drug Store News and Pharmacy Times. In 1999, Bruce started his own editorial business where he worked alongside Joan until her passing in May 2022. He continued to work up until his passing on April 17, 2026.

He loved to walk along the river, bake bread, read and spend time with his family. Bruce was a gentleman. His quiet dignity, thoughtful advice and his love and support will be missed forever.

Bruce's son Tod predeceased his father in 2001. He is survived by his grandchildren Zane (Kayla), Claire (Matt), his great grandchildren Finn and Abigail, his daughter in law Patricia and his brother Alan.
