



## Carter L. Dorzbacher

July 14, 1943 - November 9, 2024

Carter Lawrence Dorzbacher, 81, of Pleasantville, NY, passed away on November 9, 2024, from complications of acute leukemia. Born in the Bronx, Carter built a full and meaningful life surrounded by family, friends, and community.

Carter was the beloved husband of Sharon for 60 wonderful years. Together, they created a loving family, raising two sons, Michael (married to Zeny) and David (married to Sue). He was a devoted grandfather to his four cherished grandchildren: Daniel, Addison, Cameron, and Tanner. He was predeceased by his brothers, Charles and William Dorzbacher.

Professionally, Carter enjoyed a distinguished career as the Chief of the Radiology Department at Westchester Medical, where his expertise and dedication were widely respected. Beyond his professional accomplishments, he was a pillar of his community. An active member of the Union Church of Pocantico Hills, he served faithfully as both trustee and deacon, demonstrating his deep commitment to his faith and service.

Carter's passion for service extended beyond his church. He was a founding creator of the Tarrytown Sea Cadets, and parade chairman of the 1776 Bicentennial parade. Additionally, he was a very engaged member of the Masonic community. He was a member of both Lessing Lodge and Solomon's

Lodge, Master of Solomon's Lodge and District Deputy of the First Westchester-Putnam Masonic District.

A man of integrity, kindness, and dedication, Carter touched countless lives through his professional work, community involvement, and the love he gave to his family. His legacy will live on in the hearts of all who knew him.
