"Donovan Michael Anthony Marsden passed away at the age of 68 in Valhalla, NY on November 29, 2018. He was born on February 3, 1950 to Noel Marsden and Sybil Marsden in Kingston, Jamaica. Donovan and his family moved to Brooklyn, NY and shortly after he enlisted in the US Army at the age of 18. He fought in the Vietnam War (1968-1971) and was stationed in Fort Riley, Kansas and abroad in Hong Kong. After 3 years, he was honorably discharged with many medals and badges representative of his dedication to the 25th Infantry Division (Tropic Lightning), including an Air Medal and Expert Marksmanship Badge.
