



Doris (Kulinicz) Morin

February 9, 1951 - December 12, 2015

Doris Kulinicz Morin, age 64, of Irvington, died on December 12, 2015 following a 17 year battle against breast cancer. Doris was born in New York , NY to Lidia and Leon Kulinicz. She attended Sleepy Hollow High School and graduated from Connecticut College in 1973. Doris moved to Irvington in 1976 and graduated from St. John's University School of Law in 1978. Following law school, she worked at the New York Life Insurance Company. Doris then founded the Irvington firm of Blancato & Morin and later owned and operated the Irvington Realty Company. In 1997, Doris was appointed as an Assistant Attorney General for the State of New York at the Consumer Fraud Division in White Plains. A committed advocate for consumer rights, Doris obtained settlements in a number of high-profile casws involving deceptive advertising before her retirement earlier this year. Doris' children, Louis Morin III of Los Angeles,CA and Andrea Morin of Irvington,NY were the true joys of her life and she considered her herself a mother, first and foremost. In addition to her children, she is survived by her mother Lidia Kulinicz of Tarrytown, NY, her seperated husband and devoted friend, Lou Morin and her sisters Lilia Snyder and Regina Maschler. A private family only service and interment will take place at Sleepy Hollow Cemetery
