Mary Elizabeth O'Mahony, 84, passed away peacefully on October 26, 2022.

Born on January 29, 1938 to Wilhelmina and Detective Sergeant Henry Linson Wood in Tarrytown, NY. The second daughter to the couple, Mary was the younger sister of Margaret and older sister of Linson. The Wood family lived in Tarrytown until Mary was a senior in high school when they moved to Elmsford, NY where Mary graduated from Alexander Hamilton High School. 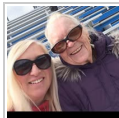
