



Peter J. Bellamy

May 27, 1967 - October 10, 2024

The family of Peter J. Bellamy is saddened to announce his passing on October 10, 2024 at the age of 57 years. Pete was surrounded by loved ones in the comfort of his home in Ossining, New York. Pete lived his life with a sense of loyalty to family, pursuit of happiness and new experiences, but most of all championing intelligence paired with kindness.

Pete was born in Saint Asaph in the United Kingdom and grew up in Colwyn Bay in North Wales. Pete was the youngest of five children to parents, Joseph and Dorothy Bellamy. He spent his youth assisting with his family's business, The Olives, exploring the Welsh seaside, and tinkering with computers.

Pete attended University at Bristol Polytechnic studying Systems Analysis. He took his first job at WH Smith's and enrolled as a reservist in Her Royal Majesty's Territorial Army.

Pete found his calling in his work as a business consultant, first with Ernst & Young, then with Capgemini. He enjoyed the challenge of working with different companies and people, keeping up with fast paced and innovative technology and traveling the world for different work projects.

It was one project that brought him to New York, New York in February of 2005. On that trip, Pete fell in love with his future wife, Aimee and immigrated

to New York. Pete and Aimee married in an epic New York Wedding in May 2009. In November 2010, Pete took on his most rewarding job as a father to his amazing son, Harrison Bellamy. In the years following, they built lives in both New York City and Wales. Pete returned to Ernst and Young, completed an MBA at Bangor University and finished his 35 year career as an executive director, global leader in his field and respected colleague.

A dear friend gave an accurate description of Pete's unique ability to "collect friends and people to him" as he saw and focused on their distinct and best qualities. Pete loved meeting new and diverse people from all over the world. His quick-witted, charming and gregarious personality won him a solid 'collection' of friends and colleagues worldwide.

Pete was a true renaissance man. He believed in charitable acts and often gave of his money, time and expertise selflessly and anonymously. He was accomplished in gardening, cooking, photography and woodworking. In his spare time, he enjoyed walking his beloved Italian Greyhounds (Duff, Monty, Tiggy, Oli and Hugo), experimenting with new technology, biking, paddle boarding and completing DIY projects on both his homes. Pete welcomed visitors and was always up for a social visit or trying out a new restaurant for drinks or food with family, friends and work mates. During the past year, Pete found peace and enjoyment with his family back at his home, Fredena, in Wales overlooking the Irish Sea.

Despite his many accomplishments, Pete's openly most proud legacy was his son, Harrison Bellamy of whom he is survived, in addition to his devoted wife, Aimee Bellamy and his loving siblings and family, Sharon Smith (Tommy Smith), Quentin Bellamy (Kate Johnson), Sarah Taylor and Miriam Bellamy (Gerry Taylor) and his in-laws, Ron and Mary Kuhn. Pete was preceded in death by his brother, Stuart Bellamy, and his parents, Joseph and Dorothy Bellamy.

Pete was an adventurous spirit and a seasoned world traveler, yet he maintained close ties with his British community of family and friends. His sense of self and heart belonged with his Welsh home in Rhos on Sea. Anyone who met him knew that the world was a better place because of this amazing human being and beautiful soul. He will be dearly missed.

Pete's Tribute Luncheon will take place immediately following the service at the Sleepy Hollow Hotel, located at 455 S Broadway, Tarrytown, NY 10591. The family invites all in attendance to his funeral service to join us.

“ A Letter to Pete’s EY Team from Geta and Michele

By now you will have seen Gil’s email regarding Pete Bellamy’s passing. As many of you know, he was a primary founder of the EY wavespace practice we know and love. He also built the foundation for the culture, priorities, and leadership standards our FSO/PE team embodies today.

What began as a ‘wild hair’ (if you knew Pete you’d agree this is an accurate representation of his ideas...and sometimes his hair!) to create a completely digital experience from the ASE’s foundation, is now a global practice that prides itself on being the convener for strategic conversations with our clients, in an innovative and human-centered manner. Pete was an innovator who constantly pushed himself, pushed his team, and pushed the firm to do things differently, think differently, and always be at the forefront of something new.

We think many of you heard have this story, but Michele and I joined EY on the same day. When we joined, wavespace was still just a concept. We barely even knew what kind of team we were joining and what we would be doing. Meanwhile, we were being onboarded in a room full of people joining EY as tax, audit, and consulting professionals who seemingly knew exactly what they would be doing. We met after Pete put us into a group chat together, and basically said, ‘you’re both on this new team together, say hello and figure it out’. We were so relieved to see we both had a 516 area code, and even more relieved that when we finally met in person, we instantly knew that we would get along. Despite our different backgrounds (and of course our shared Long Island roots), we’d knew we’d be friends, too. It was Pete’s leap of faith that put us together into that group chat, and why we’re still here today. That was Pete’s style - bring people together, and instantly trust them to ‘figure it out’, whatever ‘it’ may be - whether ‘it’ was how to navigate Welcome to EY, or how to rent a car one week into joining the firm, or how to run a wavespace session, or how to grow wavespace into

a global practice, or how to get clients to come together and 'figure it out' in a session. With Pete's leadership and vision, we shared many adventures together over the years, figuring 'it' out across the firm and sometimes even across the world.

Foundational to Pete was the team he built and led - people-first, always. Pete sought people with different backgrounds to create a diverse team with wide-ranging skills. He believed in the strength of his team and that the uniqueness of people's backgrounds and strengths made for the best possible ideas. And he advocated for them, loudly, always, to everyone at EY. A few months after joining, we remember one day, after a long delivery experience, looking around the table over drinks and noticing just how different our backgrounds were. We consisted of: an army vet, a network/systems engineer, an ex-lawyer, a computer scientist, a classically trained cellist with an architecture degree/artist, a filmmaker, and an EY ex-assurance consultant. Our band of rag-tag team members loved the green field opportunity of defining what wavespace could be, but mostly, we loved working with each other, led by Pete, who we always knew had our best interests at heart.

As we reflect on Pete's legacy, it's evident in the incredible team we have today that it's alive and well, and that people serve as the foundation of teams and always will. That's at the core of what was once the USQ wavespace team, that then became the NYC wavespace team, and that now, today, is our amazing FSO/PE wavespace pod team. We know many of you had the chance to work with Pete and we hope it was as much of a fun adventure as it always was for us. Even if you didn't get to work with Pete, his legacy is here today with all of us - in the creativity we all bring, in our individual strengths and diversity of our backgrounds, and in our support for each other. Pete was so proud of who we've all become, and of the team that we have today.

Pete touched the lives of everyone who was lucky enough to be in his, in ways big and small. We know you're probably reflecting on the ways he impacted your lives too, but if you're looking for another

way to honor and remember Pete this week, here are a few ways we think he'd appreciate:

- add milk to your cuppa (tea)*
- bake, and enjoy a baked good*
- have a chocolate martini (his favorite was at Ayza wine and chocolate bar)*
- have some Thai food (extra points if it's Spice)*

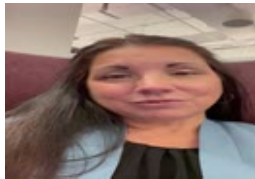

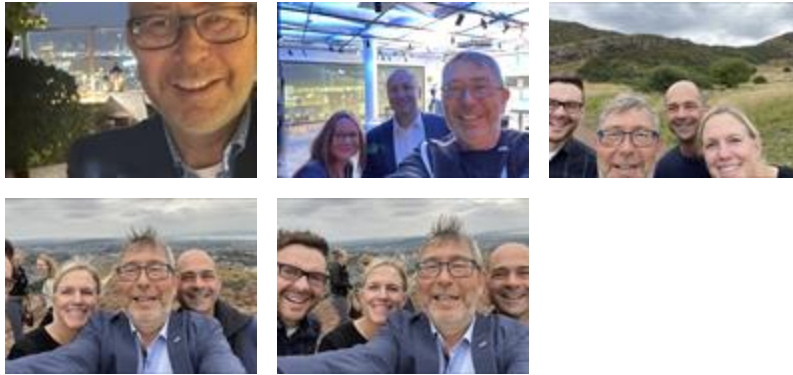

He spoke constantly of Aimee and Harrison and his love and devotion as a family man was always evident.

These events weren't always smooth sailing but Pete cut through the challenges and cultural differences with humour, energy and a bit of mischief (and a chocolate shoe).

I bumped into him just a few months ago in the lobby of our London office and he greeted me with a huge hug. We'd promised to grab a coffee but never managed it. I so wish we had.

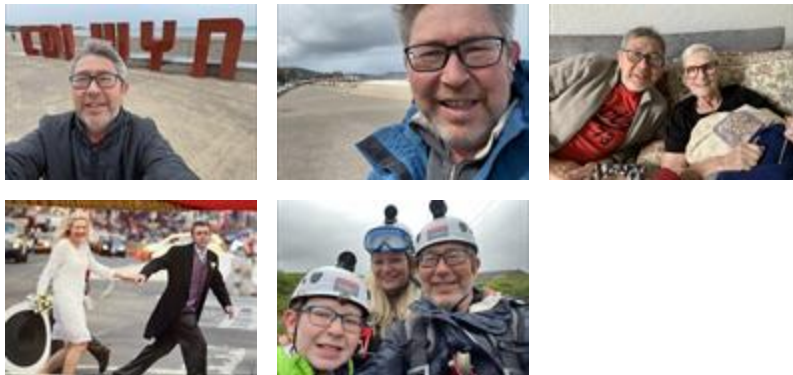
