This picture was taken when he was 43 years in at Canon and he was in the Canon turns 80 spotlight Imagine magazine. If I may quote what Pitt said in brief. When he applied for an interview at Canon he was still in college. His final interview was with Mr. Mitarai at 12 Nevada Drive in Lake Success, NY. He had two days to prepare, so he hit his textbooks. During the interview Mr. Mitarai and Pitt only discussed baseball. At the end of the interview Pitt asked him, Mr. Mitarai do you want to ask me any technical questions? He responded no. Then added, Because you know nothing, but we'll teach you." And Canon did. I asked Pitt to sign my copy and he wrote to "My good friend Pat" 11/6/17. Pitt, you will be truly missed.*
