Thomas E. Dorsett, age 66, born August 5, 1953 passed away at home on May 19, 2020, from complications of cancer. Tommy was born at New York Hospital in Manhattan to parents William and Hortense Dorsett (both deceased). Tommy moved with his family to Tarrytown, NY in 1960 and graduated from Sleepy Hollow High School in 1971. Then later in life earned his degree in business management. He ran a successful residential and commercial window cleaning company both in NY and NJ for 25 years. Tommy had two children with his first wife, Jason, 43 and Michael, 38. He married his second wife Jacqui in 1986. Jacqui has two children – Aaron, 47 and Stephanie, 44. Tommy is also survived by his two sisters, Patricia and Linda. Their oldest brother Dennis passed away. Tommy is survived by three grandchildren – Christopher, 22, Ava Rose, 5 and Kyle, 2. He will be missed by his goddaughter/niece Lisa, grandnieces Gianna and Gabriella, nephew John and grandnephew Tony.

Tommy was loved and will be missed by so many. He played high school football and was very popular. Anytime he walked through town he would be stopped by an “old buddy” of his. His wife often called him “the mayor of

Tarrytown” because he knew everyone.

Tommy had a love of music especially Motown and Classic Rock. His kids love music because of his love for music. He served as a volunteer firefighter in Tarrytown for many years and assisted at Ground Zero the day after 9/11. A memorial celebration of Tommy’s life will be announced.
