



Tyrell William Carver Sr.

December 21, 1983 - June 24, 2025

Tyrell William Carver, Sr. beloved husband, father, son, brother, grandson, uncle, and friend, of Middletown, DE, was born in Sleepy Hollow, NY, on December 21, 1983, and went home to be with the Lord on June 24, 2025.

Tyrell was the cherished son of Olesia Blalock and Tyrone Carver, and the stepson of LaTasha Hamlett-Carver. He was the beloved grandson of Hattie Blalock and the late George Blalock Sr., and of the late Lucille Carver and the late Alfred H. Bason. He is also mourned by his grandmother-in-law, Janet M. Parker of Townsend, DE. Tyrell was blessed with the love and prayers of his godmother, La Fonda Spaulding, who supported him with guidance and encouragement throughout his life.

Tyrell grew up surrounded by the love of his siblings: Tyrone Carver, Jr. (brother), Anthony Carver (brother) and his wife Cynthia Carver, LaShay Carver (sister), Selah Carver (sister), and LaChrista Brabham (sister, predeceased), each holding a unique place in his heart.

Tyrell was a proud uncle to his nieces and nephews, loving each one deeply, showing up for birthdays, games, and family moments, and leaving them with

laughter and memories they will carry forever.

He is also survived by a host of aunts, uncles, God children and many cousins who loved him dearly and shared countless moments that will live on in family stories for generations.

Tyrell was a graduate of Sleepy Hollow High School and attended Hudson Valley Community College before fearlessly stepping into the workforce to build a life for himself and his family. He began working for the Village of Sleepy Hollow as a sanitation worker, later worked at Metallized Carbon in New York, drove elderly patients to their appointments, installed cable for Cablevision contractors, and earned his CDL to drive school buses for Mile Square Transportation in Peekskill, NY. Later, he returned to private sanitation companies before fulfilling his dream of independence, proudly operating his own rig driving business for the last two years.

On August 4, 2013, Tyrell married the love of his life, Shanevea Renee Carver, in New Rochelle, NY, celebrating a love that began in July 2004. Together, they built a life rooted in laughter, loyalty, and faith, raising three incredible children who were Tyrell's greatest joy and purpose: Zyaisia Amonie Allen ("Princess") of Stamford, CT; Tyrell William Carver, Jr. ("Prince") of Middletown, DE; and Ashton Kayden Carver ("Champ") of Middletown, DE.

Tyrell is also survived by his parents-in-law, Pamela D. Scott and Gregory N. Scott of Middletown, DE, who loved him as their son; sisters-in-law Olivia S. Scott of Montrose, NY, Latoya S. Scott of Stamford, CT; and brother-in-law Gregory N. Scott Jr. of Middletown, DE.

Those who knew Tyrell knew that when he walked into a room, it lit up. He was the life of every gathering, unafraid to say exactly what was on his mind, and had a gift for making people laugh, even on the hardest days. Tyrell loved to sing (and in his mind, he was superstar-level), dance, crack jokes, and share joy with everyone around him.

He was passionate about working out, staying active, and most importantly, being present in the lives of his children. Tyrell's biggest dream in life was to be a great dad, and he exceeded that goal every single day with his love, encouragement, and commitment.

Tyrell leaves behind a legacy of laughter, strength, and unforgettable memories. His family and friends will carry forward his vibrant spirit in every cookout, every late-night conversation, and every burst of laughter that comes when remembering his stories.

Tyrell taught us to live out loud, love without conditions, and show up for family without fail. His absence leaves a space that can never be filled, but his love and memory will live on in the hearts of all who were blessed to know him.

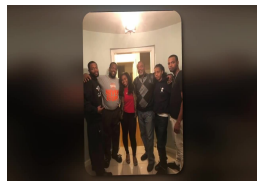
