To my dear father, Vasile Dumitrescu aka Billy, who passed away on May 17, 2020.

With bravery and sacrifice, you left everything you had known the first 30 years of your life in Romania, to begin from scratch in the United States for the sake of your family's future. What you endured for my sister and I did not become clear until we became adults and stood on our own two feet. You worked hard and constantly, but you made time to read us Romanian poems and stories at bedtime. You were generous to a fault: family members, friends, the church community and even strangers could count on you to come to their rescue.

You and mom embodied values grounded in your faith: your decency, your honesty, your absolute selflessness, your resolve in the face of adversity, and your humility stemmed for a life-long belief in God.

Our home was filled with your laughter, mandolin playing, singing and prayers. We will miss your unquestionable love for your family and your profound joy when we could all be gathered all in one place. How much you enjoyed being with people, hearing and telling funny stories. Most of all, you loved to reminisce about your childhood in Romania with your brother, Stefan. The sound of your laughter as you and Uncle Steve (Stefan) swapped stories for hours will always be in our hearts.

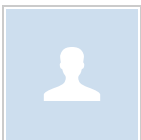
